JROTC Rifle Team Victorious

On 29 November the Paulding County High School JROTC Rifle Team had their second rifle match of the season against Hillgrove High School. Hillgrove High School Navy JROTC entered four seasoned shooters while Paulding County JROTC entered two seasoned shooters and four freshmen shooters. Rifle Team Captain Matthew Benedict led the team in the three position match with a total of 92 points out of 100 firing from the prone unsupported position. Cadet Lucas Daniels came in a close second with 91 points scored. Cadet Coby Holly scored a total of 72 points out of 100 from the hardest position, the standing unsupported. And freshmen shooter, Cadet Joseph Coleman, shot a total of 80 points out of 100 from the kneeling unsupported firing position. All in all, with support from Cadet Taylor Goodson, another Freshman shooter, the PCHS JROTC Rifle Team scored a total of 928 points earning a win over Hillgrove Navy JROTC who shot for a total of 850 points. On 1 December, PCHS JROTC scored 1004 points to Douglas County JROTC's 887 points. All 11 of the JROTC Shooters continue to practice MON-THUR honing their skills and preparing for future local meets as well as the Area 7 Meet in April 2012.
